Minutes of May 25, 1980 of meeting at Hazen's camp

1. President Ward opened the meeting at 10:25 A.M. by requesting May Hazen to read the secretary's minutes of the fall '79 meeting. Jeanette Ward asked that the minutes be amended to read as follows: "Dues and Road fees for 1980 will be collected at the Sept. meeting." Moved by M. Hazen Seconded by J. Ward. Motion passed.

2. Jeanette Ward read the treasurers report as follows:

3. L. Ward explained that he contacted companies in Hiram and Baldwin regarding fill for the road and he decided on the \$190. bid.
4. Jo Smith asked if there is a state law that indicates that each pond must have a public right of way. President Ward requested that Jo Smith check into this by asking Mr. Arnold Boalckus, game warden, and report at the fall meeting. She is also to invite Mr. Boalckus and his wife to our Pot Luck affair.
5. A motion by M. Pottle and seconded by Ruby Sprague that Bob Hazen draft and send a letter to Mr. Cheshire indicating current assoc. members whose families and friends that might be launching boats from the (public right of way). Motion passed. Letter sent, copy attached to secretaries copy of minutes.
6. R. Morse volunteered to put in buoy's (6') at the Sanger point in the second cove. Two drums and 2 half boats in the cove water will be removed by R. Morse and Walt Novack.
7. Light winter snows were discussed and the policy that members using the road on a regular basis in the winter will absorb the plowing expense will remain in effect.
8. New Business: L. Ward to contact Mr. Mitchell about joining the Assoc. - send Mr. Mitchell's information to Norton Hardware.
9. It was decided by all present to hold a "Pot Luck" affair at Hazen's Camp. Our next meeting will be held August 31, 1980 at 10:00 A.M. at Hazen's Camp with the "Pot Luck" starting at 1:00 P.M. The Assoc. will provide chicken to be purchased by J. Ward, (the amount to be purchased to be determined by the response to the attached attendance form. R. Morse has offered the use of his gas grill. Those wishing hot dogs, hamburgers etc. will bring their own.
