

The spring meeting of the Clemens Pond Association was held on May 29, 1988, at Victor and Betty Zelman's home. The meeting was opened at 10:15 by Pres. Charles Saurman. The Secretary's report was accepted as presented, and the Secretary reported that a recorder was not bought because a trial with a borrowed recorder seemed more prudent. The new Treasurer, Louise Novak reported that she could not write checks until March 1 because of the transition, and paper-work has been completed for a non-profit tax-free number. The report was accepted and approved as read. A motion was made and carried that the Association continue as custodian of the Road Fund.

Moe Rousseau reported that 150 dragonflies were picked up in Wells and planted around the pond on May 21 for mosquito control. A vote of thanks was given Victor for cleaning up the trash on the site of Notch Rd. Les Brown, Cheri & Mike new residents on the pond, were introduced. Lyn Ward stated that a \$10 fee was paid on a travel trailer considered to be a "construction trailer". The chair appointed Victor to look into the situation. Marlene Livonia spoke of the need of fire protection in the area, and it was voted and seconded that a letter be written to the Selectmen to appropriate money for a dry hydrant.

Flo Whiting stated their cottage was broken into and ransacked in April and May Hazen said they also had a break-in.

The Nomination Committee will be Judy Comer, Jo Smith and Ava Saurman.

A discussion of the water quality of the pond followed and a motion was carried that Marlene contact proper authorities about that. A motion to have a picnic was seconded, and Carol Hill volunteered to chair the committee assisted by May Hazen and Ave Saurman. It will be held on July 16 in the general area of Kenny's wagon wheel with the Saurmans, Kennys, Barbers and Rousseaus as hosts. Dick Alves and Phyllis were introduced.

At 11:40 in a motion made by Victor and seconded by Dave the meeting was adjourned.
